A Group Discussion on

“The Role of Teachers in Upholding Secularism”

Report

The Economics Association of P. G. and Research Department of Economics, Jamal Mohamed College celebrated teachers day by organizing a group discussion on “The Role of Teachers in Upholding Secularism” on 5th September 2023, Tuesday (12.00 P. M.) at the Economics Seminar Hall in the august presence of Hajee. M.J. Jamal Moahamed Bilal, President, Dr.A.K. Khaja Nazeemudeen, D.Litt., (Usa) Secretary & Correspondent, Hajee M.J. Jamal Mohamed, Treasurer, Dr. K. Abdus Samad, Assistant Secretary, and Dr. K.N. Abdul Kader Nihal, Member & Honorary Director.

The discussion started with a Welcome Address by Dr. D. Kumar, Associate Professor of Economics. Dr. A. J. Haja Mohideen, Associate Professor and Head of the P. G. and Research Department of Economics appreciated the efforts of students in organizing a group discussion on a pressing issue of upholding secularism among youth by teachers in his inaugural address. Dr. S. Ismail Mohideen, Principal, Jamal Mohamed College in his Presidential Address highlighted the secular practices in academic and administrative activities in the college campus and insisted the students to uphold communal harmony in the society.

The group discussion was initiated by Dr. A. Hidayathulla, Associate Professor of Economics by explaining the intense meaning of Secularism and encouraged the students share their views on secular practices in the classroom by teachers. Mr. Eashwar Karthick, a student of III B.A Economics and Mr. Nowfal of II B.A. Economics clearly elaborated the role of teachers in developing a secular society through positive cognitive signals to the students community.

Dr. A. Khan Mohamed highlighted the empathy towards fellow citizen’s religious practices as the vital element of secularism. Mr. Nowfal also pressed the typical role of education in bringing up a secular society. Mr. Sahubar Sadique of II M.A. Economics showed his concern over youths religious aggression even as a spectator of cricket matches.
