Resolved to approve the course structure and syllabi for **B.Voc., Food Processing and Safety** and **B.Voc., Apparel and Fashion Design** to be implemented from the academic year 2018-2019 and the same courses will be offered by the department of i). Nutrition & Dietetics and ii). Fashion Technology & Costume Designing respectively.

Resolution 23 : 02 / October 2018

❖ Question Paper Pattern for M.Phil. Programme (CIA – III & ESE)

Section A : 10 Questions x 2 Marks = 20 Marks
(Two Questions from each unit)

Section B : 5 Questions x 5 Marks = 25 Marks
(Internal Choice and one set of questions from each unit)

Section C : 3 Questions x 10 Marks = 30 Marks
(Answer any three out of 5 questions and one question from each unit)

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❖ End Semester Examination (ESE)

- Each course shall have 75 marks for the End Semester Examination
- Question papers for the end semester examination of Courses – I, II & IV shall be set externally and valued by both external and internal examiners.
- The guide paper (Course III) shall be set and valued by the respective guide.
- Candidate shall be declared to have passed course I,II,III and IV, if he / she secures not less than 40% of the marks in both CIA (10 marks) and the External Examination (30 Marks) and 50% of the marks (50 Marks) in the aggregate (i.e. continuous internal assessment and the written Examination taken together).
- The candidate is eligible to submit the dissertation only on completion of theory papers successfully.

Improvement in CIA marks for M.Phil programmes for the students admitted from the Academic Year 2018-2019 (Students admitted during and prior to 2017-18 shall refer Hand Book on Autonomy –Volume VI for old regulations)

- Students of M.Phil programmes who are unable to write the CIA Test-I / Test-II with valid reason should get prior permission from the Tutor and HOD concerned and can write the CIA Test –I or Test-II with a fee of Rs.200 per paper. Re-test request should be submitted to the COE's office within 15 days after the conduct of CIA Test –I or Test-II. Applications submitted after the deadline will not be considered for the retest. There is no retest for CIA Test-III. No internal improvement will be permitted for those who secured 10 out of 25 or more marks in CIA.
- Students who have failed in the CIA (secured less than 10 marks) are permitted to improve their CIA, on paying a fee of Rs. 500 per paper within 20 days of publication of End Semester Examinations results. Marks secured for the attendance in the particular semester shall be considered for CIA component.

Note: M.Phil. Scholars who complete the Course in more than one attempt / exceeding the stipulated Course period, will be awarded Second Class with B Grade.

❖ Dissertation

- Candidates shall submit three copies of dissertation (two copies to the College and one copy to the guide) not earlier than 5 months from the date of commencement of the second semester in the case of Full-time programme and not earlier than 10 months from the date of start of the second year, in the case of Part-Time programme. The minimum and maximum page limit shall be from 75 to 150 pages respectively. The dissertation be printed on both sides of a paper and hard bound of the same is not necessary.
- If a candidate is not able to submit his / her dissertation within the period stated above, he / she shall be given an extension time of 3 months in the first instance with a penalty of Rs.1500/- and another 3 months of second extension of time with penalty fees of Rs.3,000/-

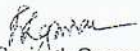
