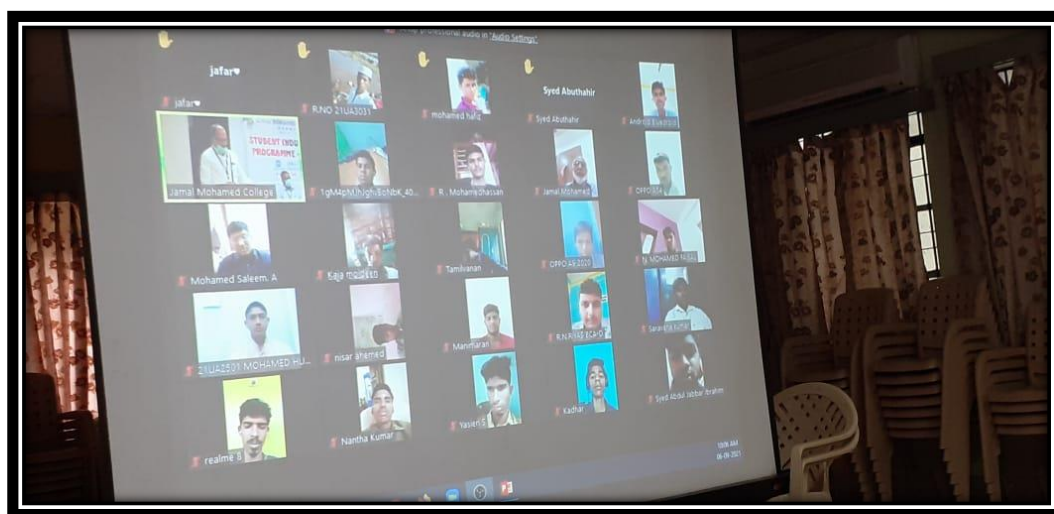

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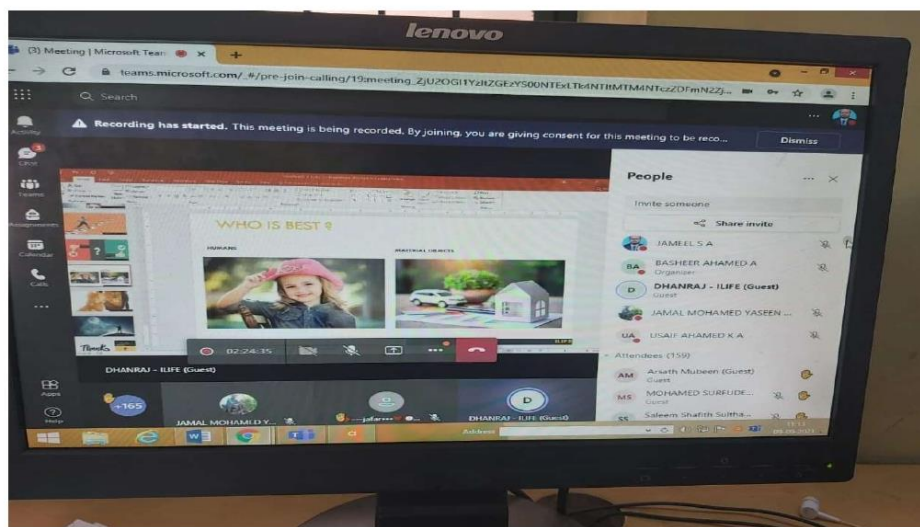

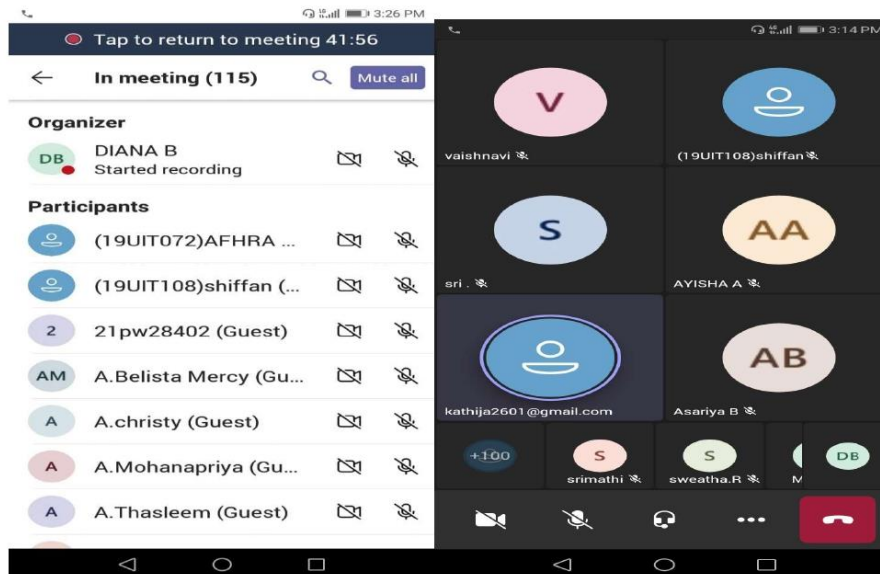

Participation of First Year UG and PG Women Students in Placement Programme on 09.09.2021





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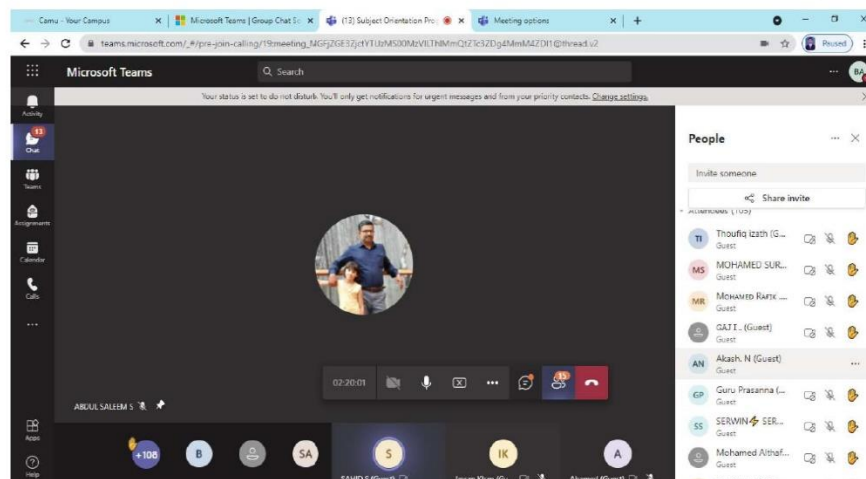
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Subject Orientation Programme for First Year B.Sc. CS Students on 11.09.2021

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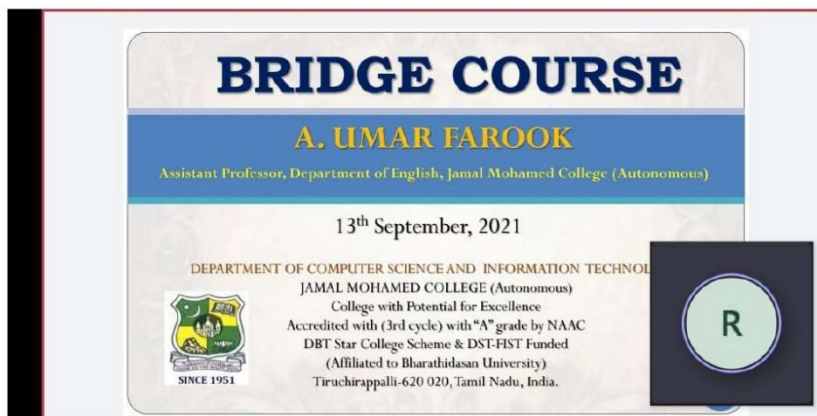
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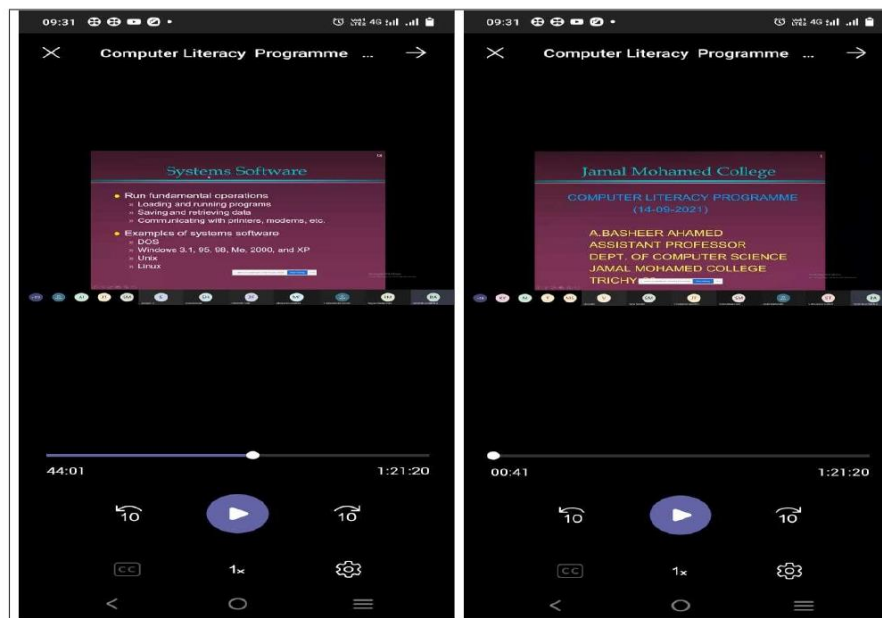

Introduction

• History & Heritage

Jamal Mohamed College was founded in 1951, as an affiliated college to the University of Madras and then affiliated to Bharathidasan University, Tiruchirappalli when it was formed in 1984. The college is administered by the Society of Jamal Mohamed College. It is established in a sprawling land area of 87 acres, as a religious minority institution. Janab. M. Jamal Mohamed Sahib and Janab. N.M. Khajamian Rowther, of revered memory, were the founding fathers of this institution. In the year 1957, the college got the single honor of being bracketed with the thirty best colleges in India when Dan forth Foundation of USA selected the college for the award of study fellowships in the U.S.A. In 1963 the college was elevated to the status of a post-graduate college. In the year 1972, the college was recognized by UGC New Delhi, for Grant purposes under section 2(F) and 12(B) of the University Grants Commission Act 1956. In 1977, on the recommendation of the University of Madras, the UGC recognized the college as one of the ten "Lead colleges" in the university area. During 2004-2005, the UGC, Government of Tamil Nadu, and Bharathidasan University conferred Autonomous status for all the programmes. The College has been accredited at Five Star Level by NAAC during 2002 and conferred with Autonomous Status by UGC, New Delhi, and Bharathidasan University in 2004-2005. In January 2009, the College was re-accredited with A-Grade - CGPA 3.6 out of 4.0. The college celebrated Diamond Jubilee functions during 2010-2011. Our College was bestowed with the unique honor of "CPE" status (Phase-II) by the University Grants Commission under the Scheme "Colleges with Potential for Excellence". We have retained 'A' Grade by NAAC during the third cycle of re-accreditation in 2016.



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The following major activities and topics may be discussed during the induction programme in which the students would be fully engaged throughout the day for the entire duration of programme, this includes.

- **Familiarization to College/Department**

During the day one day the Presidential Address & History, Heritage of JMC, Autonomy (CBCS), Recourses in the campus/Mentoring/ Introduction to all Heads of the department, and other members will be given by PRINCIPAL, Jamal Mohamed College. The Class Room Details will be delivering by Registrar of Attendance after that Department Orientation by HOD will introduce the faculties and department profile to first-year students in their respective classroom. The first year Tutor will hand over the ID to every student according to his/her roll number and explain the upcoming day's programme of SIP and hand over the SIP time table to all the students according to their batch. All the first-year students should attend SIP every day to join with their group and follow the time table.

- **Physical activity**

This would involve a daily routine of physical activity with games and sports including yoga which will help them to develop team spirit.

- **Creative arts and culture**

Every student would choose one skill related to the arts whether visual arts of performing arts examples are painting, dancing street play, music, etc. □

- **Universal human values**

It gets the student to explore self and allows one to experience the joy of learning stand up to peer pressure, take decisions with courage, etc. □

- **Literary**

Literary activities would encompass reading, writing, debating, and enacting a play.

- **Endowment Lectures by Eminent People**

Throughout the year each department can be invited more than ten special endowment lectures by eminent peoples. It would give the students exposure to socially active people, research, subject expert or are in the public domain. □

- **Visits to the local area** □

This would familiarize them with the area as well as expose them to the outer world.

- **Curriculum**

Students to expose the current curriculum and coursework in College. The students' experience, on any given campus, of any given course; each syllabus represents one sequential or supporting piece of evidence that students have indeed engaged the institution.

- **Mentoring**

The respective first-year tutor will guide whereby one person shares their knowledge, skills, and experience to assist others to progress in their own lives and careers. The tutor needs to be readily accessible and prepared to offer help as the need arises - within agreed bounds. □

- **Computer Literacy**

The literacy course will be conducted during the induction programme. The students would learn and able to use computers and related technology efficiently, with a range of skills covering levels from elementary use to programming and advanced problem-solving. By another measure, computer literacy requires some understanding of computer programming and how computers work.

- **Bridge Course in English**

During the induction programme the parallel sessions can be going for the English learning programme. This course is aimed at giving confidence to students to communicate effectively in English. The students, especially from the vernacular medium, will benefit from being able to better understand the lectures which are in English.

- **Extra-curricular activities**

In the College campus, we are giving 13 Extension and Extra-Curricular activities. Each club coordinators will be delivering their club activities, achievements, and awards received during the induction programme.

- **Library & e-content**

Fresher's to visit the Library during the period. It has 214585 volumes and subscribing over 223 periodicals and journals, ProQuest Academic Research Library, INFLIBNET-N-list, DELNET, NPTEL and open access educational resources viz., National Digital Library, ePG Pathshala, Vidya-Mitra Portal, SWAYAM MOOCs Courses for e-access to books, journals, etc. for the benefit of students, scholars and Teaching Staff.

- **Competitive Examination Coaching**

Fresher's to visit the competitive examination coaching center in the campus to expose and enroll themselves for Civil Service Examination /NET/SET/TNPSC and other competitive examinations.

- **Anti-Dowry Association**

The Anti-Dowry Association of Jamal Mohamed College was founded in 1984. 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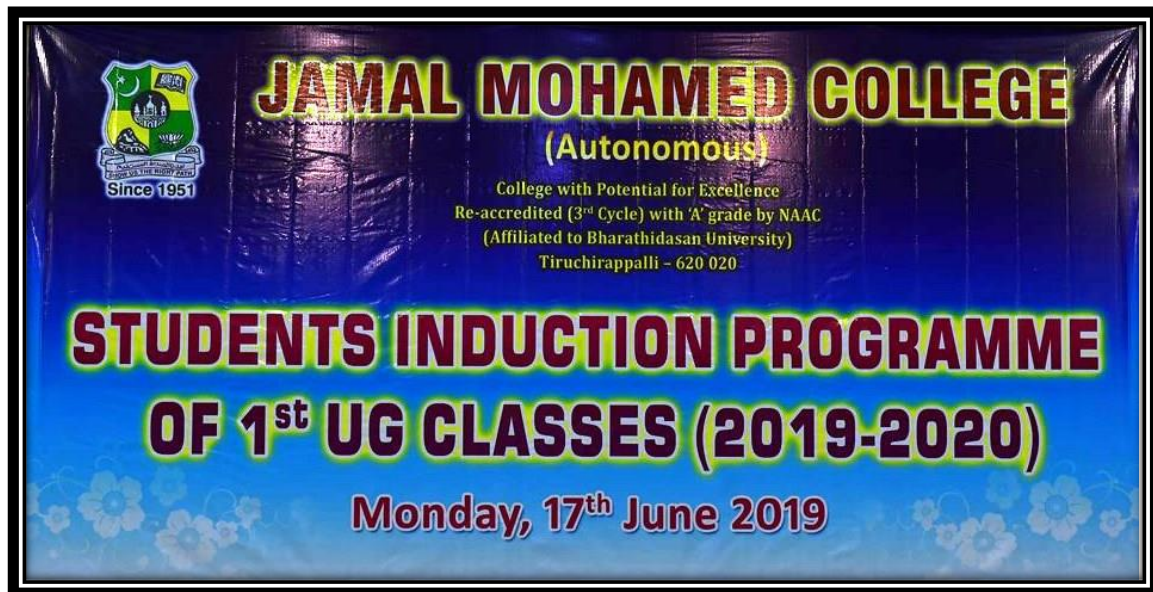
