

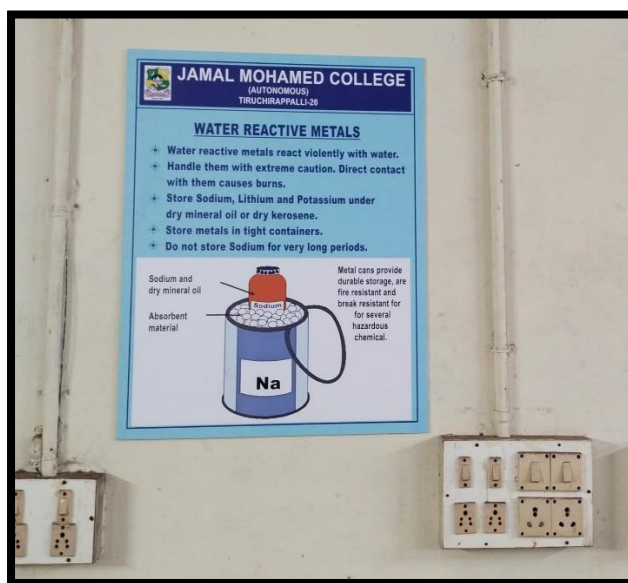
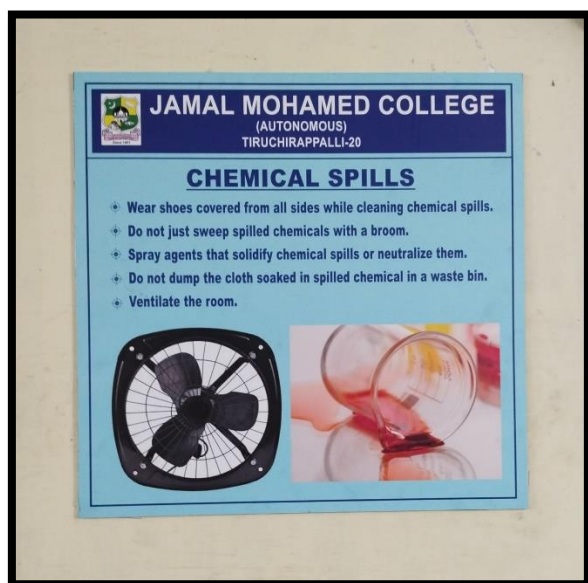


7.1.3 Describe the facilities in the Institution for the management of the following types of degradable and non-degradable waste

Hazardous Chemicals and Radioactive Waste Management

In the chemistry practicals, the use of chemicals for the tests have been reduced by adopting micro level test methods, thereby reducing the discharge of chemicals in the drains, which has remarkably lessened the impact of hazardous chemicals in the environment. A separate room for storing strong acids like Hydrochloric acid, Nitric acid, Sulphuric acid, etc. is maintained with conducive environment.

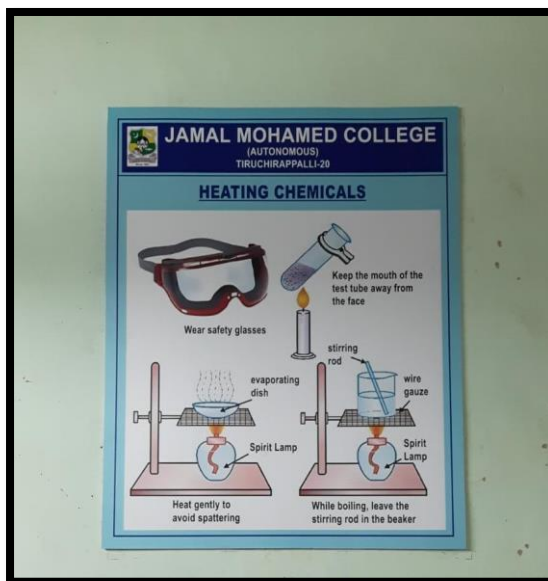
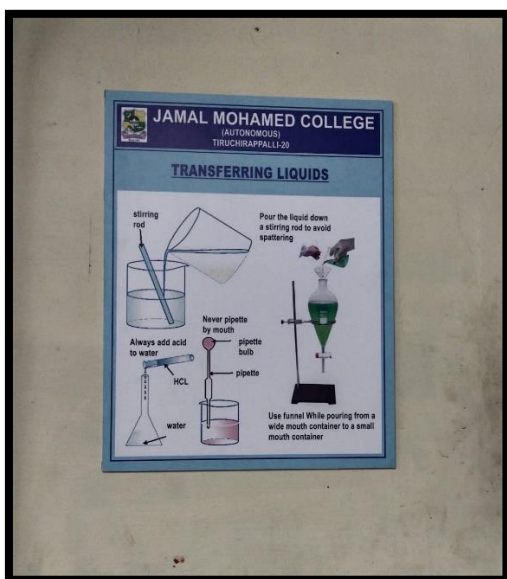
