Human trafficking is a crime that exploits women, children and men for numerous purposes including forced labor and sex. Since 2003 the UN Office on Drugs and Crime (UNODC) has collected information on about 225,000 victims of trafficking detected worldwide. Globally countries are detecting and reporting more victims, and are convicting more traffickers. This can be the result of increased capacity to identify victims and/or an increased number of trafficked victims. The Youth Red Cross and Citizen consumer club of Jamal Mohamed College, Tiruchirappalli participated in a rally on 3rd August 2019 to create awareness on the need of child support and prevention of human trafficking. Report of the Programme

A rally was conducted by Tiruchirappalli District administration, in which the 33 students of Youth Red Cross of Jamal Mohamed College took part in the rally dated on 26th June 2019. The rally held to mark the **International Drug Abuse. International Drug Abuse and Illicit Trafficking** is a United Nations International Day against drug abuse and the illegal drug trade. It is observed annually on 26 June, since 1989, a date chosen to commemorate Lin Zexu's dismantling of the opium trade in Human in Guangdong province, just before the First Opium War in China. As per the UN's 2007 World Drug Report puts the value of the illegal drug trade at US\$332 billion a year. 'Health for justice and Justice for health' is the theme for international day against drug abuse and illicit trafficking. It highlights **that justice and health are two sides of the same coin when it comes to addressing drug problems**
