Our college has been implementing the Student Project Scheme (SPS) in order to harness the talent and potential available with students for the benefit of the Society. Under this scheme first year, second year UG students and first year PG students may apply. Financial support up to a maximum of Rs. 10,000/- will be provided to each project. Those who want to apply under this scheme are requested to read the instructions carefully and apply as mentioned below.

Two hard copy of the proposal complete in all aspects is to be submitted through proper channel to Centre for Research.

• Last date for hard copy submission: 29.11.2024

How to apply

- 1. Fill in all the requested details (Format is Enclosed).
- 2. Then print the PDF and get the signature of the Guide, HOD and Principal.
- 3. After getting the signature, scan the same and send it to jmcdeanresearch@jmc.edu
- 4. Project proposals that do not adhere to the prescribed format and are incomplete will not be considered.
- Projects are considered in the sectors: AHL-Arts, Humanities, Linguistics; BS-Biological Sciences; CHS*- Chemical Sciences; ES-Environmental Sciences; FT-Fashion Technology, ND-Nutrition & Dietetics, PS-Physical Sciences; SS-Social Sciences; CSE**-CSE/IT/Computer Application/ Software.
- 6. Any clarification regarding Submission of the proposals may contact Centre for Research.

General Instructions

- 1. The student project scheme is instituted for the purpose of providing assistance in the form of grants to FIRST & SECOND YEAR students of UG/FIRST YEAR students of PG for Innovative research work.
- 2. Student projects are eligible for a maximum grant of Rs. 10,000/-.
- 3. Only one sector should be selected in the format. Incorrect filling or selecting more than one sector will lead to the rejection of your application.

- 4. The project team (batch) can have upto a maximum of four students. A team should send only one proposal. Submitting more than one proposal will lead to cancellation of all the proposals.
- 5. It may be noted that the project proposal should be original, innovative and novel. It should have utility and applicability for implementation. Kindly note that the evaluation of the project will also be based on these factors.
- 6. The Project Guides / HODs need to evaluate the project proposals and scrutinize them before sending the project proposals to Centre for Research.
- 7. The project team **should not** change the topic or deviate from the objectives of the sanctioned project proposal. In the event of any such changes, grant will be treated as cancelled and the students should return the sanctioned amount to the institute.
- 8. Project proposals received will be reviewed and evaluated by a team of experts and those selected will be announced.
- 9. The sanctioned projects should be completed and the report should be submitted before the end of November 2025.
- 10. The Utilization Certificate (UC) and Statement of Expenditure (SE) should be signed by the Guide, HOD, Bursar and Principal with official seal as applicable. The guides are responsible for timely submission of Project Report (15-20 pages), UC and SE.
- 11. If the guide wishes to leave the institution where the project is based, the Institute/ Guide must inform the Head of the Institute. In consultation with the Management, steps should be taken to ensure the successful completion of the project before the guide is relieved.
- 12. Two hard copy of the proposal should be signed and forwarded by the Guide through HOD and Principal as applicable to reach the Centre for Research on or before 29.11.2024.
- 13. Proposals received after the deadline will not be considered and no communication will be entertained in this regard.
