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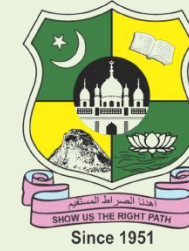

## **ABOUT THE COLLEGE**

Jamal Mohamed College was founded in 1951, as an affiliated college to the University of Madras and then affiliated to Bharathidasan University, Tiruchirappalli, when it was formed in 1982. Jamal Mohamed College is situated in the central part of Tamil Nadu, Tiruchirappalli city. It was established as a minority institution with the primary objective of providing higher education to the downtrodden and socially backward section of the society in general. The college is administered by the Society of Jamal Mohamed College. It is established in a sprawling land area of 87 acres, as a minority institution. Hajee M. Jamal Mohamed Sahib and Janab N.M. Khajamian Rowther, of revered memory, were the founding fathers of this institution. In the fourth cycle, the high performance and meritorious service of our college is accredited with A++ Grade by NAAC (4<sup>th</sup> cycle) with 3.69 CGPA out of 4.0 in 2023. The college has obtained the prestigious 59<sup>th</sup> rank among Top ranking institutions in NIRF Rankings-2024. It is remarkable to state that the college has been recognized with Three Star status by the Institutions Innovation Council (IIC), MHRD innovation cell, Government of India in 2019.

Over a period of 74 years, the college was able to scale greater heights and rise to the present status as a multi-faculty institution with 30 UG and 20 PG courses. 17 departments are functioning with the status of approved research centers with the total strength of 10656 students. There are 138 Government-aided teaching faculty and 360 staff members working under the self-finance stream.
