
Jamal Mohamed College (Autonomous) Trichy

Jamal Mohamed College wa<mark>s f</mark>ounded in 1951, as an affiliated college to the University of Madras and then affiliated to Bharathidasan University. Tiruchirappalli, when it was formed in 1982. Jamal Mohamed College is situated in the central part of Tamil Nadu, Tiruchirappali city. It was established as a minority institution with the primary objective of providing higher education to the downtrodden and socially backward section of the society in general.

The college has obtained the prestigious 56th rank among Top ranking institutions in NIRF Rankings -2023. It is remarkable to state that the college has been recognized with Three Star status by the Institutions Innovation Council (IIC), MHRD innovation cell, Government of India in 2019.In the fourth cycle, the college has been accredited with A++ Grade by NAAC with a CGPA of 3.69 out of 4.0 in 2023.




History of Fashion



Journey-Aari Work

Aari embroidery dates as far back as 12th Century and during the Mughal era. Even today many of the patterns are inspired by mughal designs and this rich form of embroidery holds a special place in the artistry of textile design in India.

Aari gets it name from the 'Aar', which is a small, hooked needle or awl used by the craftsmen

How is it created – by piercing the fabric and looping colourful threads through it with a needle. It can also be used to set beads into the embroidery.

THE PROCESS

Aari embroidery involves several steps, each of which requires a high level of skill and precision. Here is an overview of the process:

Designing:

The first step in Aari embroidery is to create a design. The design can be drawn directly onto the fabric or traced onto it using a transfer paper

Mounting:

The fabric is then mounted on a wooden frame or a hoop to keep it taut.

Threading:

The next step is to thread the Aari needle. This is done by passing the thread through the eye of the needle and pulling it through until there is an equal amount of thread on either side of the needle.

Stitching:

The stitching process begins by inserting the Aari needle into the fabric at the starting point of the design. The needle is then pulled through the fabric, creating a loop.

The needle is then inserted into the loop, and the process is repeated to create a chain stitch. The stitches are made in rows until the design is complete.
