# **REPORT**

The Faculty Development Programme (FDP) held from June 5th to June 9th, 2024, was an enriching event that focused on cutting-edge topics such as Artificial Intelligence, Sustainability in Textiles, Research Writing, and Sustainability in the Fashion Industry, Indian Technical Textile Industry, Research Practices, Esteemed experts from these fields shared their insights and expertise, providing invaluable knowledge to the participating faculty members.

We have an introductory Session on 5<sup>th</sup> June with our management and principal. On 6<sup>th</sup> June the programme commenced with an in-depth session on Artificial Intelligence, led by Mr. A K B Nawas Babu, Managing Director, S A Knitwear, Madurai. His presentation covered the fundamentals of AI, its current applications, and potential future developments, emphasizing how Artificial Intelligence can be integrated into various academic and research domains.

On 7<sup>th</sup> June 2024 the focus shifted to Sustainability in Textiles, presented by Dr. P Senthil Priya, HOD, Department of Fashion and Costume Designing highlighted the importance of eco-friendly practices in textile manufacturing, discussing innovative techniques to reduce environmental impact while maintaining industry standards.

On the third day 8<sup>th</sup> June 2024, Dr. Horne Averal Iona an accomplished Associate Professor, IQAC coordinator, presented a clear cut idea on Indian Technical Textile Industry. This session was particularly beneficial for faculty members looking to enhance their Textile Values and the session also focused on Research Writings and Publications, that provides with a clear cut knowledge on research publications. The expert gave practical tips on structuring research papers, effective literature reviews, and the importance of adhering to ethical guidelines in academic writing.

The final sessions on 9<sup>th</sup> June 2024 of the FDP addressed Sustainability in the Fashion Industry, led by Dr. Pratima Goyal, opportunities in making the fashion industry more sustainable. She introduced concepts such as circular fashion, ethical sourcing, and the role of technology in reducing waste. The Session also focussed on the Innovations in Textile Recycling which also focussed on the advancement in the textile industry.

The programme concluded with a panel discussion where participants engaged with the experts, sharing their perspectives and seeking advice. Overall, the FDP was a significant success, equipping faculty members with advanced knowledge and practical skills to implement in their respective fields.
