Jamal Mohamed College

Jamal Mohamed College was founded in 1951 as a Government aided institution. It was first affiliated to the University of Madras. With the establishment of Bharathidasan University in 1982, the college was affiliated to it. Jamal Mohamed College is situated in the heart of Tiruchirappalli city. It was established as a religious minority institution with the primary objective of providing higher education to the downtrodden and the socially backward section of the society in general and Muslim minority in particular. The college is administered by the society of Jamal Mohamed College. Hajee. M.J. Jamal Mohamed sahib and Janab N.M. Khajamian Rowther of revered memory were the founding fathers of this institution.

Over the period of 72 years, the college was able to scale greater heights and raise to the present status as a multi-faculty institution with 25 UG, 20 PG, 17 M.Phil. and 17 Ph.D. programmes. Seventeen

Departments of the college are approved research centres. The college celebrated its silver Jubilee in 1976, subsequently the Golden Jubilee and Diamond Jubilee in 2001 and 2011 respectively. It is worth mentioning that the college was accredited at 'A' Grade with Five Star status by NAAC in 2001. The Autonomous status was conferred on this institution by the UGC and Bharathidasan University in 2004-2005.

The institution has been bestowed with 'College with Potential for Excellence' status in 2011-2012. The college has retained 'A' Grade by NAAC during the third cycle of Accreditation in 2015. It is remarkable to state that the college has been categorized as band 'A' institution (rank between 6-25) in category of Institutes of colleges (Govt. and Aided) in Atal Ranking of Institutions on Innovation Achievement (ARIA) with Three Star status by the Institutions Innovation Council (IIC), MHRD Innovation Cell, Government of India in August 2020.

Five Science Departments such as Botany, Chemistry, Mathematics, Physics, and Zoology have been selected by the Department of Biotechnology (DBT) and got awarded the Star College Scheme in the academic year 2020-2021 with the financial grant of Rs. 1.04 Crore. During the Academic year 2022-2023, our college was ranked as one of the Top hundred colleges (56th Rank) in the National Institutional Ranking Framework (NIRF) - 2023 by Ministry of Education, Govt. of India. The College has secured A++ Grade with CGPA 3.69 out of 4.0 during the 4th Cycle of Accreditation by NAAC in September 2023.

Department of Chemistry

The Department of Chemistry has been functioning as one of the pioneering departments of this premier institution since its inception. It offers UG, PG, M.Phil. and Ph.D. programmes. The well-qualified faculty members of the Department actively involved in research pertaining to their chosen fields such as Organic, Inorganic, Polymer, Nano, Environmental, Phyto and Electrochemistry. Major, Minor and seed money Research Projects grant received to the tune of Rs. 61,23,000/- from funding agencies such as UGC, Ministry of Environment and Forests and TNSCST have been successfully completed. Departments such as Botany, Chemistry, Physics, Computer Science and Zoology received a grant of Rs. 1.1 Crore from DST under FIST in the year of 2019. A total number of 20 patents were filed by our faculty members in the field of Organic, Phyto and Nano chemistry and 4 patents among them were granted. The department has so far produced 115 Ph.Ds and 314 M.Phils. The Department is equipped with well-furnished laboratories and also an instrumentation centre with FT-IR, UV-Visible Spectrophotometer and Chemical Vapour Deposition Instruments.

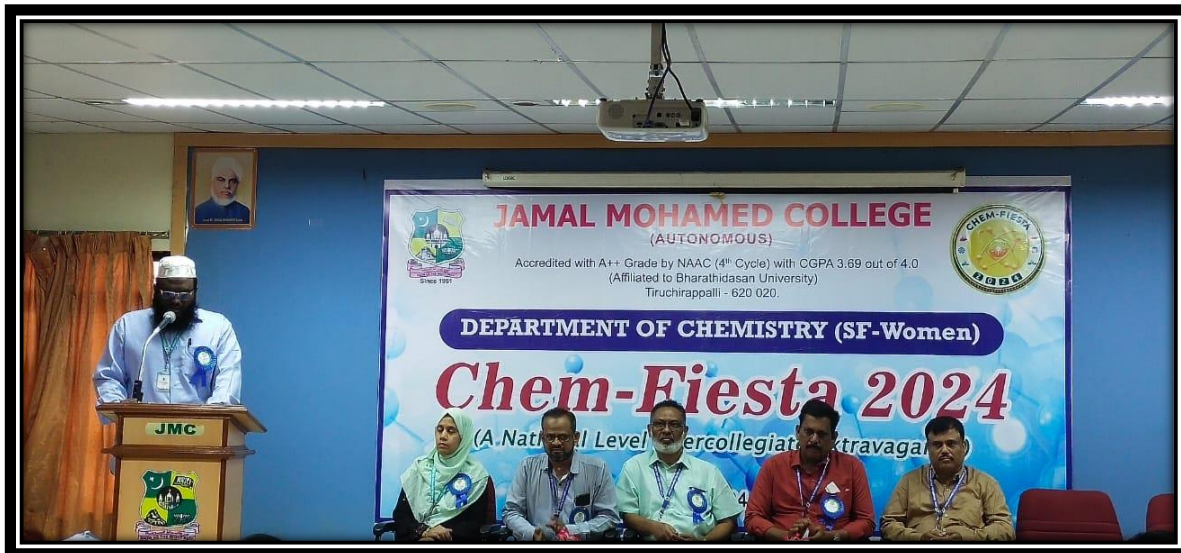

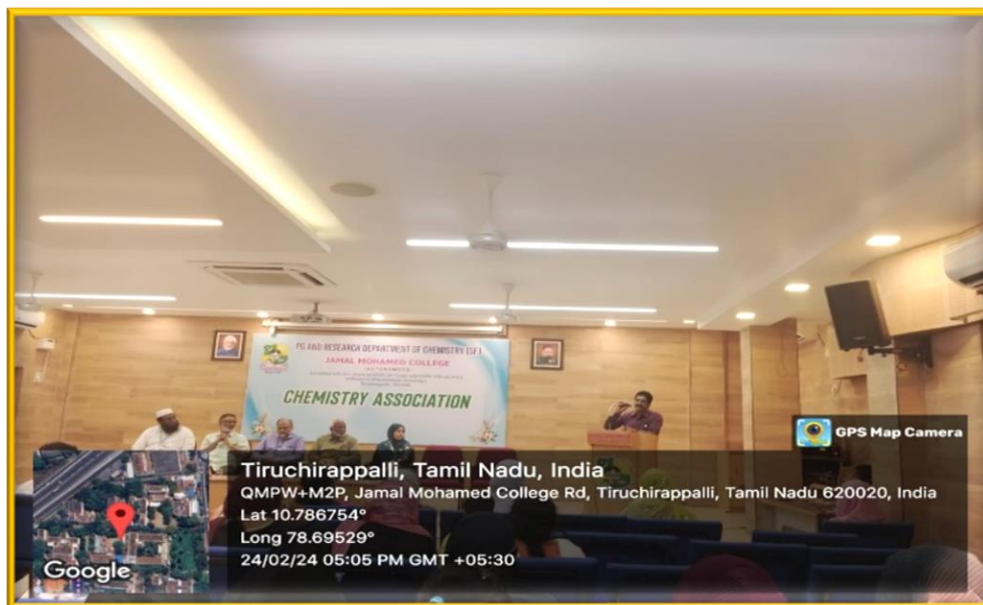
