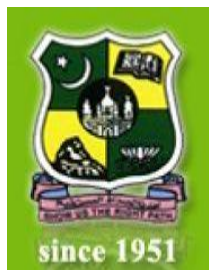

The Programme was started with the invocation by Dr. R. Abdul Vahith, Assistant Professor of Chemistry.
