

Name of the activity: Traffic rules Awareness Show



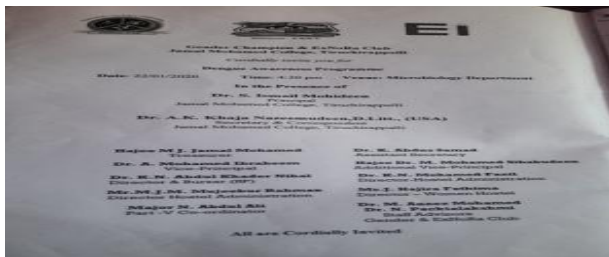
Name of the activity : Dengue Awareness Programme
