**“International day against Drug Abuse and Illicit Trafficking”**

A Webinar programme on “International Day against Drug Abuse and Illicit Trafficking” was held on 26-.06.2021. More than a hundred students of men and women participated in the Webinar.

Finally, Thiru. M. Bharathi Mohan, project Director, Khajamalai Ladies Association Integrated Rehabilitation Centre for Addicts, Trichy, explained and stressed on the important steps to be followed to eradicate the drug addiction.

1. To create awareness on drug abuse and illicit trafficking among teachers, it could be easily disseminated to the students with considerable impact.
2. To display placards on the evils on drug abuse in a vantage point of the campus.
3. To organize a trip once in a year to the nearby hospital to meet the victims of drug only to realize their practical difficulties. If the students meet the cancer patients who are addicted to drug, they would certainly avoid the wrong way.
